CCT Volunteer Timeline



- **Volunteer Application:** Volunteer applications are *due by October 28*.
- **Team Matching:** Volunteers are matched with projects based on expertise, industry experience, and areas of interest. Project managers attend a training session and finalize project scopes; teams start their work together in advance of the All Team Meeting.
- **All Team Meeting:** *January 20, 2018*, all clients and volunteers will attend a session to learn about this year's projects followed by working sessions for individual teams and clients.
- **Project Execution:** *December through May*, the team works on the project, creating work plans, dividing tasks, and collaborating on research and recommendations, meeting in-person and by conference call. In late March, at a mid-point meeting with the client, each team presents project deliverables, receives feedback, and reassesses direction.
- **Final Project Presentation:** *Late May or early June*, teams present and discuss final deliverables with clients.
- **Wrap-Up Celebration:** A wrap-up party to honor clients and volunteers will be held in *June*.
